

# Center Director Expectations

Below you will find a brief overview of the responsibilities and benefits of being a center director. If you are interested in applying for a certain bowling center you can visit <http://aht.strikeforcetour.com/center-directors> .

## Center Director Responsibilities

- Represent the SFT AHT in a professional manner at all times. This includes during competition, on the lanes, off the lanes and even outside of the bowling center.
- You must bowl at least one night a week in the center that you are directing for the entire duration of being director at that bowling center.
- You must promote the SFT AHT within the protocols that are stated in the center director contract 2 nights a week at each center. This means running win-a-spots, raffles etc.
- You must bowl at least 1 SFT AHT standard event a month.
- You must be available on the weekends for Board of Directors meetings. These meetings will normally be once a quarter.
- You are responsible for promoting at least 3 nights a week at your center if the SFT AHT has an upcoming event there that weekend.

## Center Director Benefits

- Compensation in a variety of ways:
  - o Each director will be paid hourly if requested to promote more than 2 nights in a week at their center.
  - o Each director will be paid hourly if requested to promote any night that is at a center that isn't their center.
  - o Each type of promoting (raffles, win-a-spots etc.) will have an expense fee associated to it that will compensate the center director each time he/she does these kinds of promotions.
  - o Each director may have access to special bowling tournament software for running brackets, side pots and other events at their local center. Each director can also make money off of these kinds of events, which would be much harder to run without the software.
  - o There will also be bonus and incentive programs among the directors which will involve compensation in a variety of ways.
- Each center director will have a very significant voice in the direction that the SFT AHT goes, and will play a very important role in the bowling community at their bowling center.
